Why did you choose to do an apprenticeship at Castle Water?

Another way I have found to balance the study and workload is to remember what evidence I need for my apprenticeship when I'm working so as I take calls or answer emails if something can be used as evidence I can screenshot it at that point and don't have to use my dedicated apprenticeship time to find the evidence, leaving me more time to focus on the units themselves.

Has your apprenticeship helped you gain new skills?

Yes, some of the new skills I have gained are working with new computer systems. When I started the apprenticeship, I never thought I would be so confident with the systems and programs we were shown in the first week. I have also gained skills in professionalism and workmanship when working in a professional environment and interacting with people. The biggest skill I have gained is confidence in myself and in my work, especially when it comes to telephone conversations and using the knowledge I have gained.

Has this experience helped you work towards your career goals?

Yes, the experience has helped me realise I can work and succeed in an office. It's also helped me work towards my goal of having not just a job but a career in an environment where I'm confident and capable of performing to standards.
